### Geographic Zones

3 zones Europe - Asia - Africa - Europe or vice versa  
4 zones Europe - Asia - Southwest Pacific\* - Africa - Europe or vv.  
Southwest Pacific\* (SWP) : On a direct single plane service or when transfer without stopover is utilised between SWP - Europe this will be considered a 4 continent journey  
NB : Europe Includes Middle East and N. Africa ( Algeria + Morocco + Tunisia + Egypt + Sudan )

### Routing

Travel must be in a forward circle direction. However, backtracking within a zone is permitted. The same city pairs / sector cannot be flown more than once in the samedirection. Travel may not continue through the original point of origin.  
A maximum of 20 flight segments are permitted for the entire journey.

### Minimum / Maximum stay

Minimum 10 days (date of departure of intercontinental flight + 10 days) / Max. 12 months

### Reservations

Reservations must be made for the first international flight and all preceding flights. Subsequent open sectors must be closed on above carriers.

### Advance Purchase

No advance purchase for business and first class - tickets may be issued up to 1 hour prior to departure; for economy class - ticketing timelimit depends on time of reservation and departure and could vary between 21 days before departure and 1 hour prior to departure (see GDS)

### World Traveller Plus (BA) / Surcharge

Possible against supplement : USD 300 per flight segment. Booking class T. (Except LONMEL & LONSYD : supplement is USD 450 per flight segment).

### Discounts

Children (under 12) : 25% discount (UMNR not allowed).  
Infants (under 2 years without a seat for duration of journey) : 90% discount. No agent / tour conductor discount.
