## Intercontinental Travel, without going around the world

The oneworld Circle Trip Explorer fares are based on the number of oneworld continents visited or passed through (including the continent of origin). Passengers must stop in Africa in combination with at least two of the three continents Europe, Asia and Southwest Pacific. There is no mileage calculation required.

The fare you pay is based on the number of **oneworld** Continents you visit or pass through (including your continent of origin) and the class you fly in.

Fares and conditions shown are valid for departures from Belgium and exclude taxes and applicable agency fees. 3. Asia (including the Indian subcontinent)
4. Southwest Pacific (including Australia, New Zealand, Papua New Guinea)\*

Southwest Pacific\* (SWP) : On a direct single plane service or when transfer without stopover is utilised between SWP - Europe this will be considered a 4 continent journey

Booking Class domestic flights AY/LA/LP/XL/4M:

Business/First = Y

Booking Class domestic flights JL (to/from NRT):

Business/First = J, Economy = H

Booking Class domestic flights JL/NU/JC (all other routes):

First = F, Business = J, Economy = Y

<b>Routing</b>	<p>Your journey must include at least three <b>oneworld</b> continents (including your continent of origin), one of which must be Africa. Your route from one continent to another must move forward in a continuous circle direction. Once within a continent, there are no backtracking restrictions so you are free to roam locally at will as long as you don't go back to your point of origin.</p> <p>A maximum of 16 flight segments – including surface segments - is permitted for the entire journey.</p> <p>Travel is not permitted on CX flights between Hong Kong and Hanoi.</p>						
<b>Minimum / Maximum stay</b>	Minimum 10 days (date of departure of intercontinental flight + 10 days) / Max. 12 months						
<b>Reservations</b>	Reservations must be made for the first international flight and all preceding flights. Subsequent open sectors must be closed on above carriers.						
<b>Advance Purchase</b>	No advance purchase for business and first class - tickets may be issued up to 1 hour prior to departure; for economy class - ticketing timelimit depends on time of reservation and departure and could vary between 21 days before departure and 1 hour prior to departure (see GDS)						
<b>Baggage regulations</b>	Piece concept.						
<b>Upgrades</b>	Upgrading permitted but the fare must be recalculated from point of origin. Upgrading by sector to First / Business is not permitted.						
<b>Premium Economy :</b>	<p>Available on BA (World Traveller Plus), JL and QF on payment of following supplement per flight segment :</p> <table border="0"> <tr> <td>1. <b>Discounts</b>	<p>Children (under 12) : 25% discount (UMNR not allowed)</p> <p>Infants (under 2 years) : 90% discount</p> <p>No agent / tour conductor discount</p>						
<b>Stopovers</b>	<p>In zone of origin (Europe) a maximum of 2 free stopovers are allowed. <b>Transfers</b>	Unlimited online / interline transfers permitted on <b>oneworld</b> members only, subject to sector limitations.						
<b>Endorsement box</b>	VALID ON ONEWORLD ONLY / NONREF						



## Cancellations / Refund

- before ticketing : full refund provided ticket is presented before departure of first flight segment.
- after ticketing : charge 10% of ticket amount for economy tickets, 5% for Business and First class tickets. For partially used tickets, charge the difference – if any - between the fare paid and the fare for the itinerary used.

## Changes

- before departure : unlimited changes allowed without charge
- after departure : date / time changes allowed at no charge. Route changes allowed at USD 125 per transaction.

## Group Travel

Group travel is permitted for Business and Economy Class travel only

Eligibility :	No requirements
Minimum Group Size :	Economy Class : 10 passengers (Max : 30 passengers) Business Class : 10 passengers (Max : 15 passengers)
Accompanied travel :	Group required to travel together for entire itinerary
Documentation :	No requirements
Name changes / additions :	Not permitted after the ticketing deadline
