



# oneworld Combinable Fares

For departures from the Netherlands  
10 November 2009

## Mix and match

Published fares from all **oneworld** airlines out of the Netherlands are now combinable on a half round-trip basis to create round-trips, circle-trips and open jaws. Combinability is no longer restricted to full fares but is allowed for all the published fares as stipulated in the fare rules, with the most restrictive rules applying to the entire journey.

As an example, you can now travel from Amsterdam to Hong Kong on Cathay Pacific and return on British Airways at the best published fares that each of the airlines have available for your journey.

All **oneworld** airline operated flights are included and fares can be auto-quoted through your GDS.

## How to book oneworld Combinable Fares

- Simply book an outbound and return flight on any of the **oneworld** airlines.
- Auto price the itinerary, looking for the lowest available fares.
- The price quote will automatically take into account which fares can be combined as well as availability.
- Issue the ticket.
