### Travel around the Atlantic with oneworld Circle Atlantic Fares

oneworld Circle Atlantic fares are offered from points in Switzerland to the USA/Canada, Mexico, South America and Europe/Middle East. The fare requires a transatlantic crossing between North America and Europe/Middle East, a transatlantic Crossing between South American and Europe/Middle east, and a Western Hemisphere crossing between South America and Mexico/USA/Canada. Travel must begin and end in Switzerland..

**Discounts**  
Children (under 12) : 25% discount.  
Infants (under 2 years) : 90% discount.  
Unaccompanied children not allowed



## Routing

Fares and travel only apply on AA/AY/BA/CX/IB/JL/LA/MA/MX/RJ

Travel is between cities in Switzerland, the USA/Canada, Mexico, South America and Europe/Middle East. The fare requires :

1. A transatlantic crossing between North America & Europe/Middle East
2. A transatlantic Crossing between South American & Europe/Middle east
3. A Western Hemisphere crossing between South America & Mexico/USA/Canada.

The same city pairs/segments cannot be flown more than once in the same direction. Travel must not exceed a total of 16 flight segments. Travel between two airports by surface transportation will count as one flight segment.

Travel must originate at any point for which fares are published and must terminate at the same point, or an alternative point in the country of origin.

## Minimum / Maximum stay

Minimum 7 days (date of departure of intercontinental flight + 7 days) / Max. 12 months

## Stopovers

- 17,000 miles: 4 free stopovers
- 21,000 miles: 5 free stopovers
- 25,000 miles: 6 free stopovers

No more than two stopovers per continent.

All itineraries require a minimum of two stopovers, one in each continent (excluding continent of origin).

## Transfers

Unlimited transfers permitted subject to mileage/sector limitations  
Not more than 2 transfers in any city permitted

## Surface Travel

Surface segments are permitted. Travel between two airports by surface transportation will count as one flight segment.

## Reservations / Advance Purchase

Reservations for the first international flight and all preceding flights must be made prior to departure. Subsequent segments may be open-dated.

## Ticketing deadlines

Tickets may be issued up to one hour prior to departure.

### Exception:

For economy class reservations made 22 or more days before departure ticketing must be completed at least 21 days before departure.

For economy class reservations made 21 to 8 days before departure ticketing must be completed at least 7 days before departure.

For economy class reservations made 7 days or less before departure ticketing must be completed prior to departure.

## Cancellation fees & Refunds

After ticket issuance -

Forfeit 10% of ticketed fare for Economy Class fares.

Forfeit 5% of ticketed fare for Business/First Class fares.

## Rebooking / Rerouting

After ticket issuance :

Date/time/oneworld carrier/inventory changes are permitted provided ticketed points remain the same.

Changes other than to date/time/oneworld carrier/inventory permitted at a charge of USD125.00 per transaction.

After departure :

No Show requires rebooking at a charge of USD125.00

If the rerouting results in a change to the total ticketed miles, the ticket shall be recalculated.

Tickets may be reissued to a higher fare, e.g. from an LCIRAT17 to an LCIRAT21 and the increase in fare will be collected. When the rerouting results in a reduction to the original ticketed miles, no refund will apply.

## Group Travel

Group travel is permitted for Business and Economy Class travel only

Minimum Group Size : Economy Class : 10 passengers (Max : 30 passengers)

Business Class : 10 passengers (Max : 15 passengers)

Accompanied travel : Group required to travel together for entire itinerary

Name changes / additions : Not permitted after the ticketing deadline

Ticketing carrier's Group policy shall apply

Booking Class : Economy Class - G Business Class - I

## Upgrading of fare type

Upgrading permitted but the fare must be recalculated from point of origin. Upgrading by sector to First / Business is not permitted.
